Bablekos MD, MSc, PhD, Assistant Professor in the Occupational Therapy Department, University of West Attica, Athens, Greece, with known object **“Applied Medical Treatment of Clinical Lesions in the Human Body”**, is graduate of the Medical School of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Greece, with grade very well (7), on November 4th, 1992. Dr Bablekos’ Medical Specialty is “Thoracic Surgery” (date of receipt, on November 22th, 2006).

Dr Bablekos is also possessor of a Doctoral Thesis (date of receipt on October 22th, 2002, with grade “Excellent”), performed under the supervision of the Department of the Experimental Physiology of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, Athens, Greece. The known object of Dr Bablekos’ PhD Thesis focuses on physiological disturbances regarding Static Lung Volumes & Capacities, Flow Rates and Control of Breathing Parameters, emerged in the sequel of laparoscopical surgical procedures in the upper abdomen.
